## SWS SUPPLEMENTARY DOCUMENTATION FOR DEFERRED EXAMS (DE) APPLICATIONS

The role of the DSA's Student Wellness Service (SWS) is to provide a clinic-based therapeutic service. For clarity, the SWS staff do not have any influence on the decisions of the Deferred Examination Committee (DEC).

Students who wish to apply for the Deferred Exams (DE) are invited to attend any of the SWS service sites during the exam period, and the operating hours are advised below.

The SWS will continue to provide its regular service, and students who require therapy and counselling will be assisted by making an appointment through the usual channels on the <u>online</u> booking platform.

**Students known to SWS** for prior chronic medical and psychological therapy will not need to be re-assessed for the DE application. They may complete the <u>ACA44a form</u>, Sections A and B only, and hand it to the SWS practitioner for completion.

These students can access the SWS main clinic, Ivan Toms Building, 28 Rhodes Ave, Mowbray, as early as 3 weeks before their exam date.

## **SWS Deferred Exams service hours and sites**

Students may visit any SWS service sites below during the exam period and bring along the ACA44a form so the clinician can complete the relevant sections. Students should not perceive a signed supplementary form to mean that the Deferred Examinations Committee will approve it; it is merely a support document.

## **Online Booking System:**

Students can log into the <u>booking</u> system and select the next available slot under the medical or counselling appointment tabs. The same SWS consultation fees as the other basic consultation fees apply for an assessment for deferred exams at all SWS service points. ### **Key points to note**

- Students do not need to make appointments for the DE support services provided at the two service sites, the Upper Campus Clinic and the SWS Main Clinic.
- The service is a walk-in service and works on a first-come, first-served basis. No students should submit their applications after the stipulated 7 days after the exam, citing booking themselves a slot beyond the 7 days.
- Sections A and B of form <u>ACA44a</u> need to be completed by the student, and Section C needs to be completed by the SWS clinician.
- Form ACA44a will be given to the student immediately.
- **Students new to SWS and** applying for the DE must visit any of the DE service sites listed above for a clinical assessment and to complete the **ACA44a** form.
